Outreach

- Participates in Harbour's In the Harvest Ministry at least twice

- Maintains prayer weekly for the NIS ministry
- Actively meets with two or more international students for intentional discipleship (weekly/biweekly)
- Encourages Harbour congregants to volunteer with NIS
- Intentionally connects with Harbour's current international students on Sunday mornings and encourages them on their spiritual journeys
- Assists in leading a weekly discovery Bible study or conversation circle with NIS
