Campus Outreach Intern

Job Purpose:

The campus outreach Intern will grow in their personal faith and servant-leadership capabilities as they facilitate gospel ministry to their peers at Brock U or Niagara College. To grow as a strong disciple of Jesus, who makes disciples of others, and multiplies gospel groups on campus.

Spiritual Profile and Qualifications:

- Demonstrate a Christian lifestyle that reflects the qualifications of a Deacon found in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1
- Able to enthusiastically embrace the Vision, Mission, Values and Philosophy of Ministry of Harbour
- Able to fully agree with the doctrinal statement of Harbour and be able to minister within the Fellowship of Evangelical Baptist Churches of Canada (FEB)
- Is teachable, with the desire to go deep in their faith, and learn about church ministry.
- Is moving towards membership at Harbour Fellowship Church.

Responsibilities:

Communication:

- Maintains open and regular communication with supervisor
- Collaborates humbly with other volunteer leaders and interns

Discipleship

- Actively growing as a disciple of Jesus through personal spiritual disciplines, church participation, and weekly mentorship meeting with supervisor.
- Modeling active discipleship of students on campus

Campus Outreach

- Bus captain for the “Bus to Church” program on Sunday mornings. Fostering a strong sense of community and welcome among the bussers, helping them connect to the broader church community.
- Works with supervisor to execute “move-in mission” reaching new students as they arrive on campus through ITH and social activities during the first two weeks of school.
- Helps to facilitate a consistent outreach presence at their campus (eg. In the Harvest biweekly)

Young Adult Ministry

- Participates on the young adults leadership team and in the vision of multiplying gospel groups.
- Intentionally looks out for new young adults on Sunday mornings at church or other events to invite them into community

Working Conditions:

- Establishes and maintains a positive and collaborative work environment with all staff and volunteers
- Invited to staff meetings on Tuesday mornings at 11am (optional)
