Job Title: Summer Ministry Intern-Camps

Reports To: Summer Camp Director

Job Purpose:

The Summer Ministry Interns will report to and be mentored by the Summer Camp Director. They will work alongside the Family Ministry Team to lead and develop programming for children, youth and summer camp. It will involve teaching, leading teams, curriculum implementation, event planning and administration. The successful candidate must have a passion for the next generation and the local church. This position is seasonal.

Education & Experience:

Education/Experience

- Be between 15-30 years of age. High School diploma preferred.
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred.
- Have a valid social insurance number and are legally entitled to work in Canada.

Status:

- Temporary: June – August
- \$17.60/hr

Responsibilities:

- **Teaching:** Lead groups of kids and youth based on curriculum material.
- **Team Leadership:** Lead volunteer teams in various programs and activities providing guidance and supervision.
- **Collaboration:** Work alongside other staff and interns in a team setting.
- **Curriculum Implementation:** Work with our summer camp curriculum to create excellent daily programming for summer camps. This will include various elements from interactive activities, crafts, outings other creative elements.
- **Event Planning:** Develop and lead special events for kids and youth along with the Family Ministry team that promote community outreach.
- **Administration:** Oversee camp registration, payments, volunteer communication, and website updates.
- **Care:** Provide care and leadership to children and students when needed, and under guidance of Family Ministry staff.
- **Support:** Work with the Family Ministry staff to provide extra support for students and kids with additional needs.
- **Social Media:** Provide support and monitoring of our social media profiles and platforms.
- **Sunday Morning:** Participate in elements of the Sunday morning services as needed.
